GENERAL INFORMATION, INSTRUCTIONS AND REMINDER ITEMS

Background Information: Brigadier General Noel F. Parrish Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen, Incorporated™ is part of a unique organization dedicated to the preservation of the history of African American Veterans whose service during World War II demonstrated to America that the criteria for responsible citizenship are character and achievement rather than ethnic origin. The Tuskegee Airmen were black, white, male and female – but above all a highly dedicated, motivated and intelligent group of individuals banded together for the liberty and equality of our great nation.

In accordance with the Original Tuskegee Airmen's standard of excellence, each year the B.G.N.F.P. Chapter grants scholarship awards to deserving young men and women. Each year the number of available scholarship awards is directly related to income received from contributions to the Education Fund. An award or awards are available, depending on contributions, each year. Awards are for one year only, must be applied for each year, and will be granted on a continued basis at the sole discretion of the Educational Scholarship Committee as directed by the B.G.N.F.P. Chapter membership.

Eligibility Requirements: Applicants must be students in good standing of their University or College in the year that they apply. Additionally, applying students must have a GPA of at least (2.00) on a four-point scale. Deference will be given to students who are actively involved in bettering their community.

Application Procedure: Application forms and instructions may be obtained from members of the Brigadier General Noel F. Parrish Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen, Incorporated. Completed applications must be time-stamped to the specific address indicated on page 1 of this application on or before March 1, 2015. **Each applicant must complete the entire application and provide all attachments listed on the bottom of the application form.** Indicate Mr./Ms., all signatures, phone numbers and dates to be included. Use N/A if not applicable. **Strict adherence to all portions** of the application form should be observed; omissions and incomplete responses will be deducted in the review process. Presentation of the submission should be neat and in order. A single staple in the upper left hand corner to keep the package intact.

Selection Procedure: Applications for scholarship assistance received by the Brig. General Noel F. Parrish Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen, Inc. are screened, verified for accuracy and appropriateness, and evaluated. Using a scale of one hundred (100) points, the committee considers academic achievement, extra curricular and community activities, relative financial need, recommendations, and essays to rank applicants.

Notification Procedure: Finalists (selectees and non-selectees) will receive individual notices of results by the end of April from the Brig. General Noel F. Parrish Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen, Inc. Educational Scholarship Committee.

Award Payment Certification: Scholarship awardees may enroll in the institution of their choice. Upon completion of enrollment, the school registrar must send verification of enrollment and curriculum to the Brigadier General Noel F. Parrish Chapter of Tuskegee Airmen, Inc. When the required verifications have been received, individual award payments, made payable to the institution on behalf of the student, will be mailed to that institutions financial office.

Award Payment Limitation: All scholarship awards will be paid within one year from date of selection notification.
